## **WP4 Call for Proposals**

# E3UDRES2 Scientific Council

### 1. Summary

This document is intended to start the establishment of a Scientific Council to provide advice on scientific matters to the E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> alliance. The council should be the relevant body for academic and strategic aspects of research activities, integrated into the E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> structure.

## 2. Objectives/Responsabilities

The Council:

- Makes recommendations and supervises the research work under WP4.
- Validates the revisited joint E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> Research strategy, prepared by the WP4 team, reflecting previous EU policies, previous activities & experience, integrating capacity of all nine partners, before being sent for approval to the Executive Board.
- Supervises the implementation of the E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> Research networks policy approved by the Executive Board.
- Supervises the definition of the concept of E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> Applied Research Centres of Excellence (CoE), proposed by the WP4 team (including criteria, characteristics, role and potential benefits), to be submitted to the Executive Board for aproval.
- Identifies and selects the relevant future CoE from the expressions of interests received through the E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> Call and propose them for further development in view of the decision by the Executive Board.
- Supervises the definition of the E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> Joint Doctoral Programmes concept, methodology & policy (including criteria, characteristics, joint methodologies, model & rules, mobility models, conditions for candidates, financing models etc).
- Validates the proposed E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> Joint Doctoral Programmes concept, methodology & policy, before being sent for approval to the Executive Board.
- Supervises the implementation of the selected Joint Doctoral Programmes.
- Monitors quality and performance of the joint research activity.
- Advises on any other problems related to E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> joint research activities.

### 3. Composition of the Scientific Committee

The Scientific Council is composed of senior researchers/scientists from all partners.

Each partner should appoint qualified experts (internationally recognized researchers, with previous experience in research management and administration).

Proposals should be accompanied by a CV/biography focused on research experience (such as expertise on scientific committees, coordination of R&D&I projects and other scientific activities, membership in professional associations, academies etc). The CV

should also include the main scientometric indicators (ORCID ID, Researcher ID, h-indexes for WoS – Scopus – ScholarGoogle).

The Chair of the Scientific Council will be elected in the first meeting of the Council.

#### 4. Selection of the Scientific Committee members

The members of the Scientific Council will be selected from the received proposals by the WP4 team, after analysing the profile of each proposed member and will be sent for final aproval to the E³UDRES² Executive Board.

### 5. Proposals for the Scientific Committee members

The proposals for the members oft he Scientific Committee have to be made according to each partner's internal strategy, but they should respect the principles stated in article 3 and should include all relevat data in the attached CV.
